

## No Salvation Without Revelation

Salvation cannot come without revelation;<sup>1</sup> it is in vain for anyone to minister without it. No man is a minister of Jesus Christ<sup>2</sup> without being a Prophet. No man can be a minister of Jesus Christ except he has the testimony of Jesus; and this is the spirit of prophecy.<sup>3</sup> Whenever salvation has been administered, it has been by testimony.<sup>4</sup> Men of the present time testify of heaven and hell, and have never seen<sup>5</sup> either; and I will say that no man knows these things<sup>6</sup> without this.

## Signs of Second Coming Have Commenced

Men profess to prophesy. I will prophesy that the signs of the coming of the Son of Man<sup>7</sup> are already commenced. One pestilence will desolate<sup>8</sup> after another. We shall soon have war and bloodshed.<sup>9</sup> The moon will be turned to blood.<sup>10</sup> I testify of these things, and that the coming of the Son of Man is nigh, even at your doors.<sup>11</sup> If our souls and our bodies are not looking forth for the coming<sup>12</sup> of the Son of Man; and after we are dead, if we are not looking forth, we shall be among those who are calling for the rocks to fall upon them.<sup>13</sup>

## Hearts of Children Turn to Fathers

The hearts of the children of men will have to be turned to the fathers, and the fathers to the children,<sup>14</sup> living or dead,<sup>15</sup> to prepare them for the coming of the Son of Man. If Elijah did not come, the whole earth would be smitten.

There will be here and there a Stake [of Zion] for the gathering of the Saints.<sup>16</sup> Some may have cried peace,<sup>17</sup> but the Saints and the world will have little peace<sup>18</sup> from henceforth. Let this not hinder us from going to the Stakes; for God has told us to flee,<sup>19</sup> not dallying, or we shall be scattered,<sup>20</sup> one here, and another there. There your children shall be blessed, and you in the midst of friends where you may be blessed. The Gospel net gathers of every kind.<sup>21</sup>

I prophesy, that that man who tarries<sup>22</sup> after he has an opportunity of going, will be afflicted by the devil. Wars are at hand,<sup>23</sup> we must not delay; but are not required to sacrifice. We ought to have the building up of Zion<sup>24</sup> as our greatest object. When wars come, we shall have to flee to Zion.<sup>25</sup> The cry is to make haste.<sup>26</sup> The last revelation says, Ye shall not
